ANCHOR Project (an action-based research project providing substance abuse and mental health treatment, sexual health, employment, education, and housing for LGBTQ young adults) (SIROW conducts project activities and research).

SIROW – Central (181 S. Tucson Blvd, Suite 101; Tucson, AZ 85719):

Pregnant/Postpartum Women & Youth Substance Abuse Treatment National Cross-Site Evaluation (a national cross-site evaluation to assess the effectiveness of substance abuse treatment for pregnant & postpartum women and adolescent /young adults (SIROW conducts research).

Juvenile Drug Court/Reclaiming Futures (JDC/RF) National Cross-Site Evaluation (a national cross-site evaluation of the CSAT and OJJDP funded initiative to assess and improve the efficacy of juvenile drug courts (JDC) by integrating the JDC: Strategies in Practice Model with the Reclaiming Futures Model (RF) (SIROW conducts research).
