- Submit an abstract and one chapter of your thesis that in your judgment best represents the contribution and scholarship of your project. - *Include on a separate page, 1) the name of your advisor or thesis chairperson, and 2) a mailing address, phone number and email address where you can be contacted during the summer.*
